

Science Direct

Science Direct is a database of 2,500 journal titles, many of them full-text. It covers a wide range of science subjects and even includes some “In press” or pre-publication journal articles.


For restrictions on the use of material downloaded from electronic resources, please refer to the NICSeLibrary copyright guidelines.

1. To access the database:

- Go to homepage of the NICSeLibrary;
- Click on Electronic Resources and select A-Z, then S;
- Click on the Science Direct link;
- The Science Direct homepage page will appear.
- Click Help at any time for assistance or click on the About Science Direct link at the bottom of every page. Online tutorials are also available.

2. To carry out a general subject search:

- Enter your search term eg. greenhouse gas emissions, and click on Go;
- Results page will appear;
- Select Date on the right for most recent information to be displayed first;
- You can narrow your results by entering further terms on the left; OR
- Limit your results by ticking Content Type, Journals, Topic or Year;
- Click on an article title to see an abstract, or the full text if it is available. Full text is indicated by the green square beside a title.

- You can email, export or download the article, by clicking on the icons;
- Advanced Search and Expert Search options are found by clicking on the Search tab; and
- When your session is completed, click on Logout at the top right.

3. To find a specific article:

- On the homepage, use Quick Search by entering article title (or keywords), author and journal title; OR
- Simply enter the journal title, volume, issue and page details and click Go;
- If available on Science Direct, the journal issue or article will appear; eg. an article in the journal Health Policy, volume 95, issue 2-3, pp103-112.

4. To browse in a specific journal:

- On the homepage, enter the journal title eg. Applied Soil Ecology, into the relevant Quick Search box;
- If available on Science Direct, the journal title will appear;
- A green key will indicate whether full text is available;
