Social Need (Grants) Act (Northern Ireland) 1970

1970. Chapter 13

An Act to authorise the payment of certain grants towards
expenditure incurred by reason of special social need
in urban areas. [9th June 1970]

BE it enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, and the
Senate and the House of Commons of Northern Ireland
in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:—

1.—(1) The Ministry of Community Relations may out of
money provided by Parliament pay grants, of such amounts as it
may with the consent of the Ministry of Finance determine, to
local authorities, statutory authorities or other persons whomso-
ever in respect of expenditure incurred by them by reason of the
existence in any urban area of special social need.

(2) Grants under this section may be paid at such times,
subject to such conditions and on account of such expenditure as
the Ministry of Community Relations may determine.

(3) In this section "local authority" has the same meaning as
in section 1 of the Local Government and Roads Act (Northern
Ireland) 1968 and "statutory authority" means a body (by what-
soever name called) established under an enactment of the Parlia-
ment of Northern Ireland or of the United Kingdom. c. 30

(4) This section shall be construed as one with section 1 of
the Ministry of Community Relations Act (Northern Ireland) c. 20
1969.

2. This Act may be cited as the Social Need (Grants) Act Short title.
